SHALL A COUNTYWIDE SALES AND USE TAX OF EL PASO COUNTY, COLORADO, AT THE RATE OF ONE PERCENT (1%) BE LEVIED AND IMPOSED FOR A FIVE-YEAR PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1986, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31 1990, AND SHALL ALL OF THE REVENUES OF SUCH SALES AND USE TAX BE DEPOSITED INTO A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO BE DISTRIBUTED SIXTY (60) PERCENT TO THE COUNTY AND FORTY (40) PERCENT TO THE MUNICIPALITIES IN THE COUNTY FOR CAPITAL EXPENDITURES, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROPOSAL AND RESOLUTION NO. 85-318, General-70 OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SAID COUNTY?
