QUESTION 1.

"Shall the Board of Education of School District No. 49, El Paso County, Colorado, be authorized to contract a bonded indebtedness, to be issued in one or more series, in a principal amount not exceeding \$875,000, to bear interest at a net effective interest rate not exceeding 10.75% per annum, and each such series of bonds to mature serially within 25 years of their date, for the purpose of constructing, equipping, and furnishing an auditorium for Falcon High School, and the remodeling of science classrooms, such bonds to include covenants, agreements and details required or permitted by law as may later be determined by the Board, such bonds to be paid by a general ad valorem tax which may be levied on all taxable property within the District without limitation as to rate or amount, or from any other legally available revenues of the District?"

"Shall the Board of Education of School District No. 49, El Paso County, Colorado, be authorized to contract a bonded indebtedness, to be issued in one or more series, in a principal amount not exceeding \$450,000, to bear interest at a net effective interest rate not exceeding 10.75% per annum, and each such series of bonds to mature serially within 25 years of their date, for the purpose of constructing, equipping, and furnishing the addition of a gymnasium to the existing Stetson Hills Elementary School, such bonds to include covenants, agreements and details required or permitted by law as may later be determined by the Board, such bonds to be paid by a general ad valorem tax which may be levied on all taxable property within the District without limitation as to rate or amount, or from any other legally available revenues of the District?"
