"SHALL THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 20, EL PASO COUNTY, COLORADO, BE AUTHORIZED TO CONTRACT A BONDED INDEBTEDNESS, TO BE ISSUED IN ONE OR MORE SERIES, IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$26,330,000, TO BEAR INTEREST AT A NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE NOT EXCEEDING 14.00% PER ANNUM, AND EACH SUCH SERIES OF BONDS TO MATURE SERIALLY WITHIN 25 YEARS OF THEIR DATE, FOR THE PURPOSES OF ACQUIRING AND IMPROVING SCHOOL GROUNDS; ENLARGING, IMPROVING, REMODELING, REPAIRING, AND MAKING ADDITIONS TO SCHOOL BUILDINGS; CONSTRUCTING AND ERECTING SCHOOL BUILDINGS; AND EQUIPPING AND FURNISHING SCHOOL BUILDINGS, SUCH IMPROVEMENTS TO INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO AN ADDITION TO AIR ACADEMY HIGH SCHOOL, A NEW HIGH SCHOOL BUILDING, A NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BUILDING, AND FOR REMODELING AIR ACADEMY JUNIOR HIGH FOR NEEDS OF A MIDDLE SCHOOL, SUCH BONDS TO INCLUDE COVENANTS, AGREEMENTS AND DETAILS REQUIRED OR PERMITTED BY LAW AS MAY LATER BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD?"

QUESTION:

"Shall the Board of Education of School District No. 20, El Paso County, Colorado, be authorized to contract a bonded indebtedness, to be issued in one or more series, in a principal amount not exceeding \$28,925,000, to bear interest at a net effective interest rate not exceeding 14.00% per annum, and each such series of bonds to mature serially within 25 years of their date, for the purposes of acquiring or purchasing buildings or grounds; improving school grounds; enlarging, improving, remodeling, repairing, and making additions to school buildings; constructing and erecting school buildings; and equipping and furnishing school buildings, but only in conjunction with a construction project for a new building or for an addition to an existing building or in conjunction with a project for substantial remodeling, improvement or repair of an existing building, such improvements to include but not be limited to a new middle school building, four new elementary school buildings, and remodeling and additions to Douglass Valley, Edith Wolford, Pine Valley and Rockrimmon Elementary Schools and Challenger Middle School, such bonds to include covenants, agreements and details required or permitted by law as may later be determined by the Board?"
