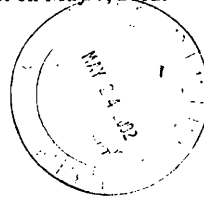

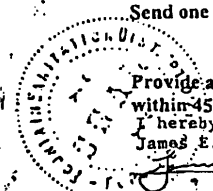

QUESTION #1

SHALL FOUNTAIN SANITATION DISTRICT DEBT BE INCREASED \$1,720,000, WITH A REPAYMENT COST OF NOT MORE THAN \$3,075,000; AND SHALL FOUNTAIN SANITATION DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$163,000 ANNUALLY, OR BY SUCH LESSER ANNUAL AMOUNT AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PAY THE DISTRICT'S DEBT. SUCH DEBT TO CONSIST OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, NOTES, OR OTHER OBLIGATIONS ISSUED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE COSTS OF CONSTRUCTING, COMPLETING, AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING IMPROVEMENTS AND MODIFICATIONS TO THE SEWER SYSTEM OF THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION IMPROVEMENTS NECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH STATE AND FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL LAWS; SUCH DEBT TO BEAR INTEREST AT A NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE NOT TO EXCEED 6.5% PER ANNUM, SUCH DEBT TO BE ISSUED AT ONE TIME OR FROM TIME TO TIME AND TO MATURE OR BE PAYABLE IN NOT MORE THAN 20 YEARS AFTER ISSUANCE, TO BE PAID FROM ANY LEGALLY AVAILABLE MONIES OF THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING THE PROCEEDS OF AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES; SUCH TAXES TO CONSIST OF AN AD VALOREM MILL LEVY IMPOSED WITHOUT LIMITATION OF RATE AND IN AMOUNTS SUFFICIENT TO PRODUCE THE ANNUAL INCREASE SET FORTH ABOVE OR SUCH LESSER AMOUNT AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO BE USED SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE PRINCIPAL OF, PREMIUM IF ANY, AND INTEREST ON THE DISTRICT'S DEBT; AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF ANY SUCH DEBT AND THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAXES, ANY OTHER REVENUE USED TO PAY SUCH DEBT, AND INVESTMENT INCOME THEREON CONSTITUTE VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGES AND BE COLLECTED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING, OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION?

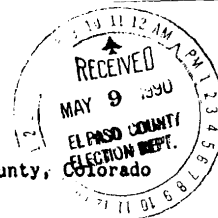

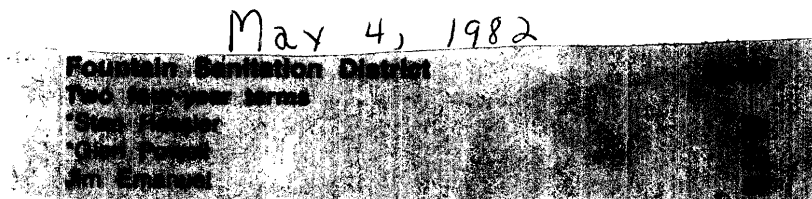
