SALES AND USE TAX QUESTION

Shall a Townwide sales and use tax of Palmer Lake, Colorado, at the rate of two percent (2%) be levied and imposed on the sale of tangible personal property at retail and furnishing of taxable services in the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado, and the storing, using, or consuming of any construction and building materials and motor and other vehicles within the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado beginning January 1, 1986, and shall all of the revenues of such sales and use tax be divided with (a) One-half of all revenues added to the Roads Fund of the Town of Palmer Lake, and (b) One-half of all revenues added to the General Fund of the Town of Palmer Lake, all in accordance with Ordinance 11-1985 adopted at a Special Council Meeting of October 4, 1985 by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palmer Lake?

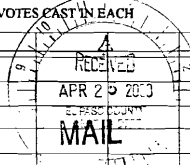


WHEREAS, three of the candidates have agreed to accept the two year position, and the other candidates have agreed to accept four year positions; and
