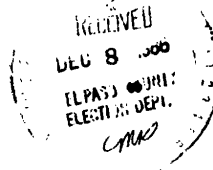

CERTIFICATE OF RESULT OF ELECTION

Each of the undersigned hereby certifies that the following is a true and correct statement of the result of the Special Election held in Stratmoor Hills Fire Protection District, El Paso County, Colorado, on Tuesday, December 2, 1986, at which there was submitted to the electors of the District, the following question:

QUESTION NO. 1 (Incurring Indebtedness to Provide Fire Protection Facilities):

"Shall Stratmoor Hills Fire Protection District, El Paso County, Colorado, incur indebtedness in the principal amount of \$150,000 and evidence the same by certificates, notes, debentures, contracts, and/or the issuance of general obligation bonds for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, installing, and completing fire protection facilities to include fire stations and all other facilities, equipment, and property rights necessary or convenient therefor, the maximum net effective interest rate to be paid on such indebtedness not to exceed 10% per annum, any such evidences of indebtedness to mature serially or be payable within 10 years from the date of incurrence, to be redeemable at the option of the District at such time or times and in such manner, upon payment of such premium or premiums, if any, not exceeding 3% of principal, such indebtedness to be paid by a general ad valorem tax which may be levied on all taxable property within the District without limitation as to rate or amount, or from any other available revenues of the District?"

Broadmoor fire district passes tax increase

Peyton OKs bond for fire station

Voters in the Broadmoor and Peyton fire protection districts Tuesday approved a tax increase and bond issue, respectively.

Residents of the Broadmoor Fire Protection District, on a vote of 44-3, approved a tax increase that will generate about \$11,000 annually for the district's operating budget, said district President Herb Goldstein. The money has been targeted for retirement and Social Security payments. The vote increased the district mill levy to 4.1 mills from 3.6 mills.

Residents of the Peyton Fire Protection District, by a vote of 98-27, approved a \$135,000 bond issue to build a fire station, buy equipment and operate the newly formed district.

Peyton had been protected by an all-volunteer fire department that operated solely on donations.

"A lot of people out here in this area feel the fire service needs better and safer equipment," said Ronald Lowe, district secretary. "We tried to run an honest campaign and let the people know what we would do with our money, and they decided to trust us on it."

tion of the fire district on Oct. 4. That vote also established a levy of 4 mills to provide for the operation of the district.

District officials said the levy will be sufficient to repay the bonds; no mill increase will be necessary. Bond money will be used to pay for operating expenses until the district collects its first tax dollars in 1990.

Lowe said the new fire station is expected to be built next summer.

When the new station is completed, the old station will be used for administrative offices.

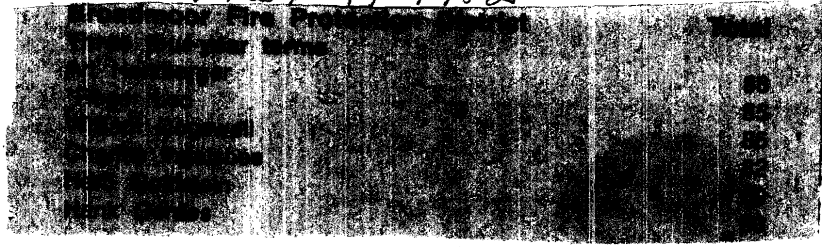

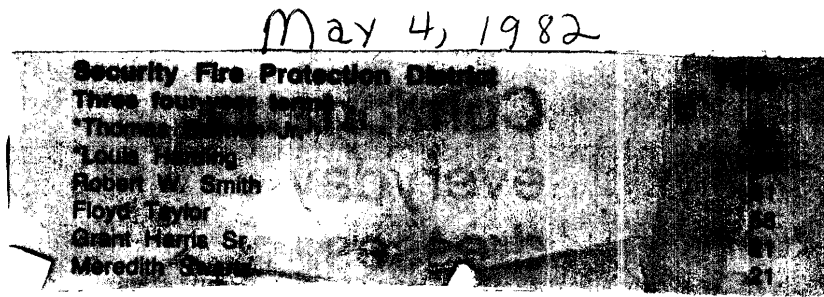

PEYTON — Voters in the newly formed Peyton Fire Protection District will return to the polls Tuesday to decide whether \$135,000 in bonds should be issued to provide operating expenses for the district, a new fire station and fire equipment.

Polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. in the Peyton School Administration Building, 13990 Bradshaw Road.

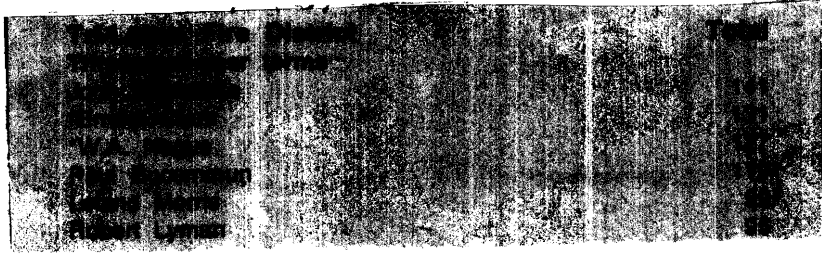
The residents approved formation of the district by a 137-31 vote Oct. 4. They also approved a 4 mill levy, which

would be used to pay off the bond issue, according to the fire district board. The bond issue will not require a tax increase, the board said.

The \$135,000 would be used to pay for a six-bay fire station and new equipment. It also would pay for expenses involved in issuing the bonds and provide operating expenses until the district collects its first taxes in 1990.

The existing fire station, built with donations, would be used for administrative offices, maintenance and training.
