- 26 DUP** – Election official is knowledgeable that the elector was erroneously sent to the wrong precinct or erroneously given the wrong ballot style in the elector's correct precinct. Voted ballot will be duplicated so that all races and issues for which the elector is qualified to vote shall be counted.
- 3 EJ** – Election judge who was appointed after close of early and absentee voting and is working outside his/her precinct; judge shall vote on a ballot in the precinct he/she is working at; voted ballot will be duplicated so that all races and issues for which the elector is qualified to vote shall be counted.
