Ballot Update Election Returns

- 384,783 total ballots issued
 - Total Ballots Returned 141,793 (Rejected & Accepted)
 - 35.61% Voter Return Rate
 - 34,677 Democratic voters (40%)
 - 72,659 Republican Voters (45%)
 - 34,037 Unaffiliated Voters (21.9%)

Returns by method

- USPS (mail)- 63,642 (45%)
- Drop box-74,157 (52%)
- VSPCs-1,066 (in person), 1,656 (mail ballot)

Risk Limiting Audit

- Participated in the statewide Risk Limiting Audit Friday, July 6
- Completed it in the first round with 100% accuracy
- Sophisticated post-election audit
 - Allows officials to compare a sample of paper ballots against digital tallies to verify results were tabulated correctly.
 - Due to the high level of statistical probability, this audit confirms the initial outcome of election night and reassures a statistically high level of confidence in testing for election results.
