INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER

MARK BALLOT AND LEAVE MARKS SHOWING
 (Your marks must be showing for vote to register)
THEN TURN RED VOTER'S SWITCH TO RECORD VOTE
 (Switch is located at lower right)

- VOTING MACHINES ARE VERY EASY TO OPERATE. JUST FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE INSTRUCTIONS
1. Step inside the curtains. Once inside, the election official will throw a switch closing the curtains behind you. You will see your ballot listed on the machine.
 2. Turn the lever next to the candidate of your choice. A big "X" will show to remind you who you are voting for. If the ballot says "Vote for 3 or 5" you may turn only that many levers.
 3. If you turn a lever in error or change your mind, return that lever to its normal position and vote for the candidate of your choice.
 4. There are spaces on the side for write-in candidates, numbered to match each office.
 5. When you're satisfied with your choice of candidates, just turn the red voter's switch at lower right. This records your vote, erases the "X" marks and opens the curtains.

To vote for a person not on the ballot, open the slot below numbered the same as the office number, and write in his name.

Shall the City of Colorado Springs be authorized to issue, in one series or more, its interest-bearing, special obligation revenue bonds in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$7,500,000 for the purpose of constructing and otherwise acquiring a convention center, including a site therefor, each series to mature serially within not exceeding twenty-five (25) years from date, to bear interest at a net effective interest rate of not exceeding ten percent (10%) per annum, to be payable solely from and secured by a pledge of any combination of the net revenues of the convention center and the City food, beverage, lodgers, automobile rental or other privilege taxes, and to be issued and sold in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as the City Council may determine pursuant to applicable law at the time of issuance, including provisions for the redemption of bonds prior to maturity without or with the payment of a premium?

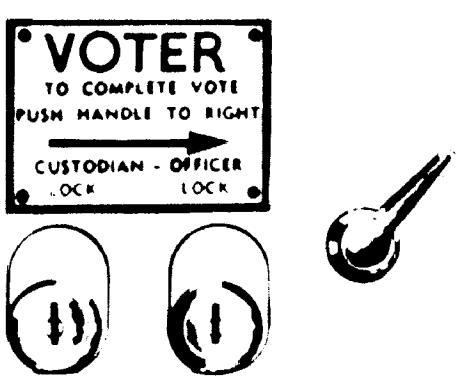
