AIRPORT EXPANSION BONDS**

**MUNICIPAL AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT BONDS TO BE
ISSUED IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$30,000,000**

Shall the City of Colorado Springs be authorized to issue its interest-bearing, general obligation bonds, in one series or more, in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$30,000,000 for the purpose of improving the Municipal Airport; such bonds to be payable from general ad valorem taxes without limitation as to rate or amount and to be issued and sold at one time or from time to time in such manner and amounts, maturing not later than thirty (30) years from the date or dates of each such issue, at such interest rates and upon such terms and conditions and with such covenants and agreements and with such other details as the City Council may determine, including at the option of the Council, without limitation, the pledging of all or a portion of the net revenues from the Municipal Airport to the payment of such bonds and provisions for redemption of bonds prior to maturity with or without the payment of a premium?
