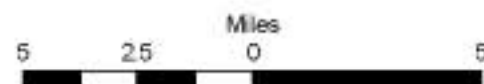

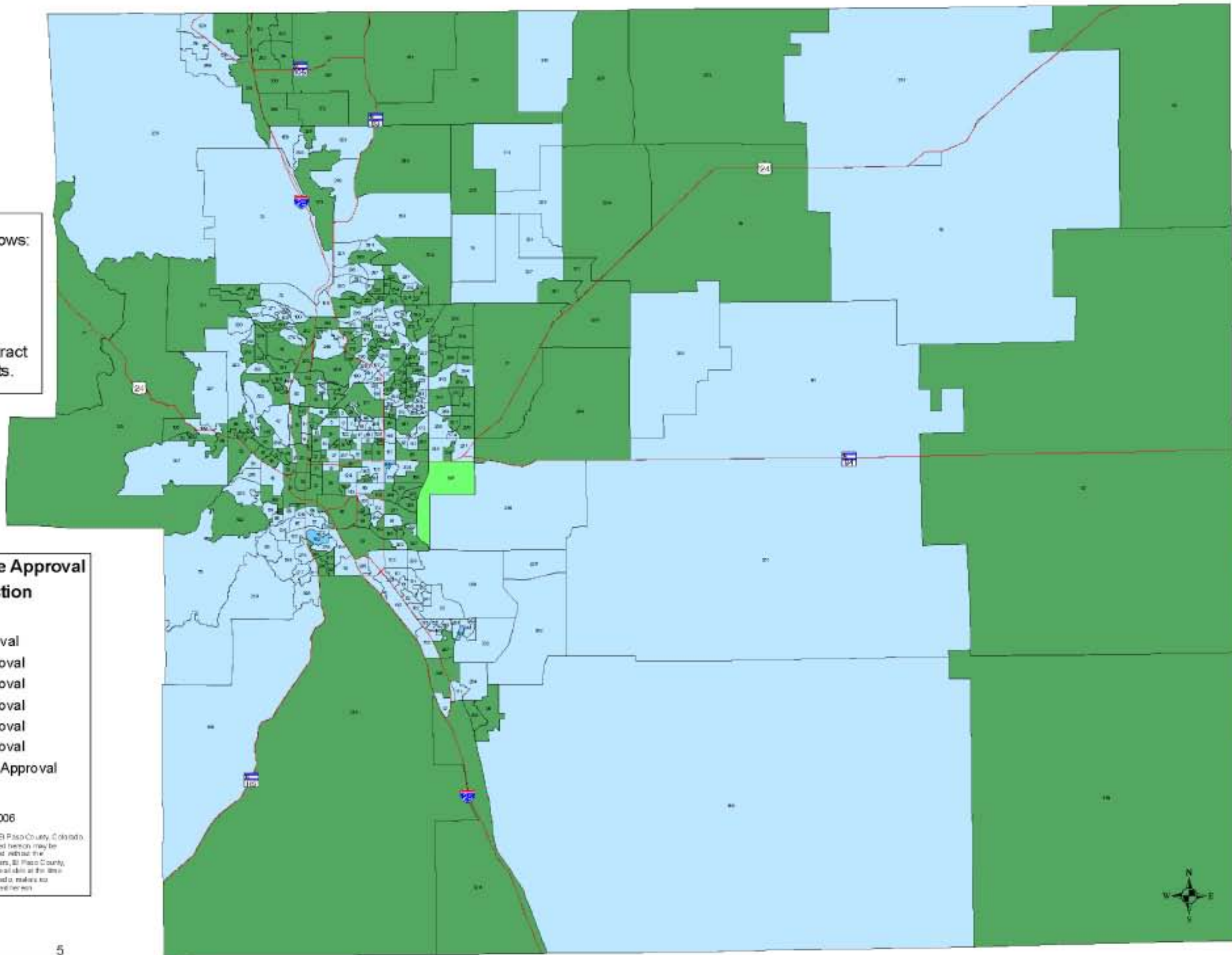

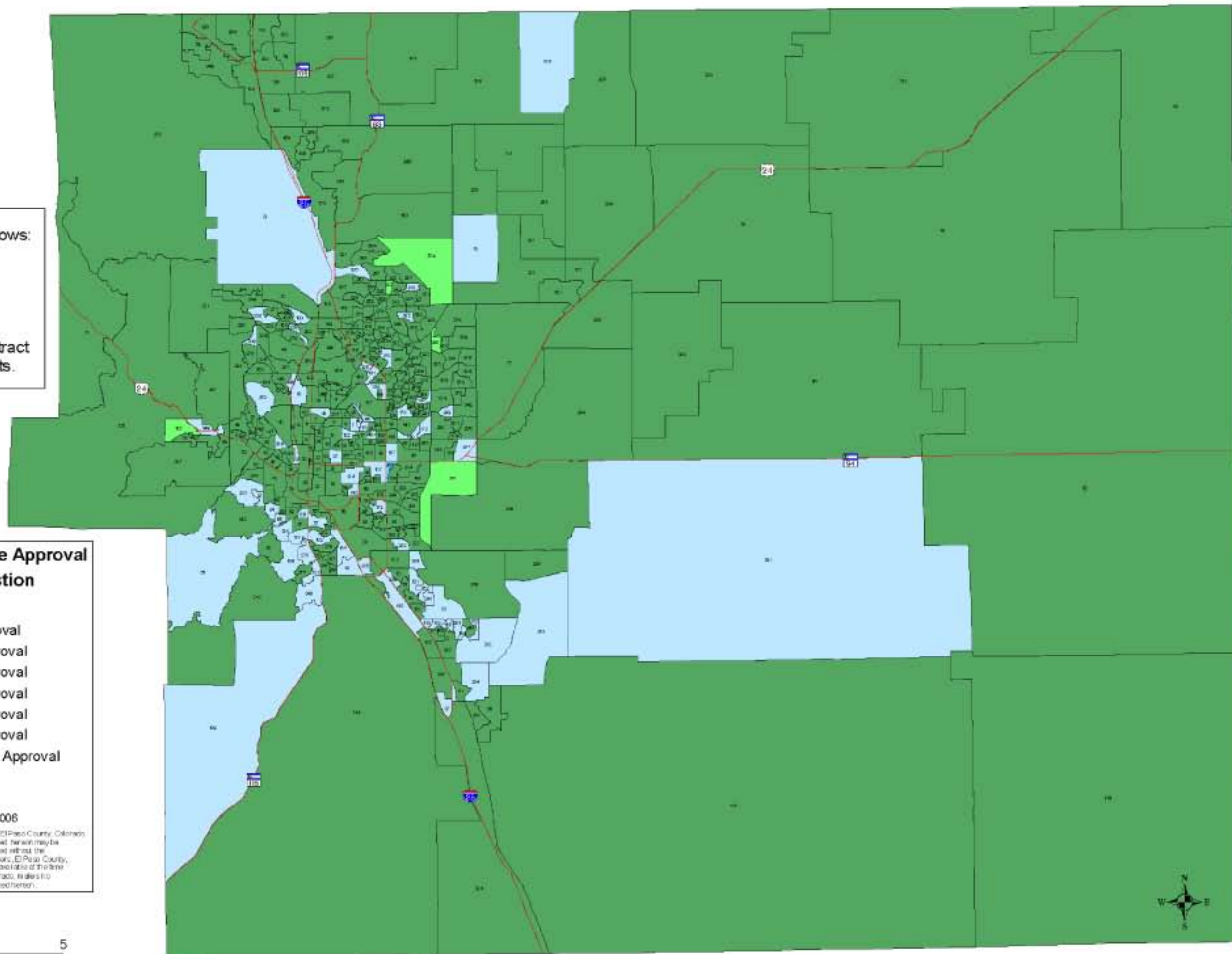

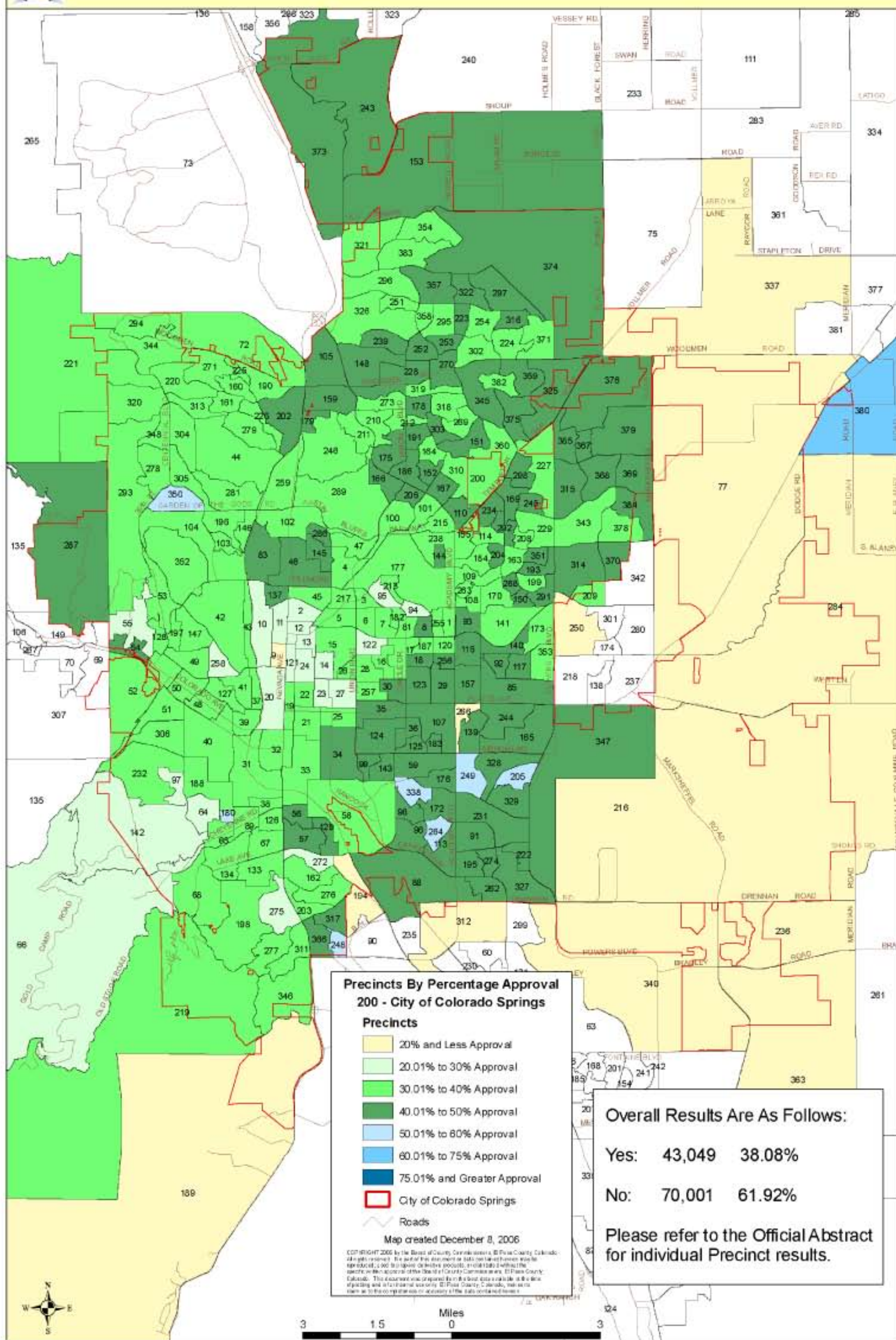

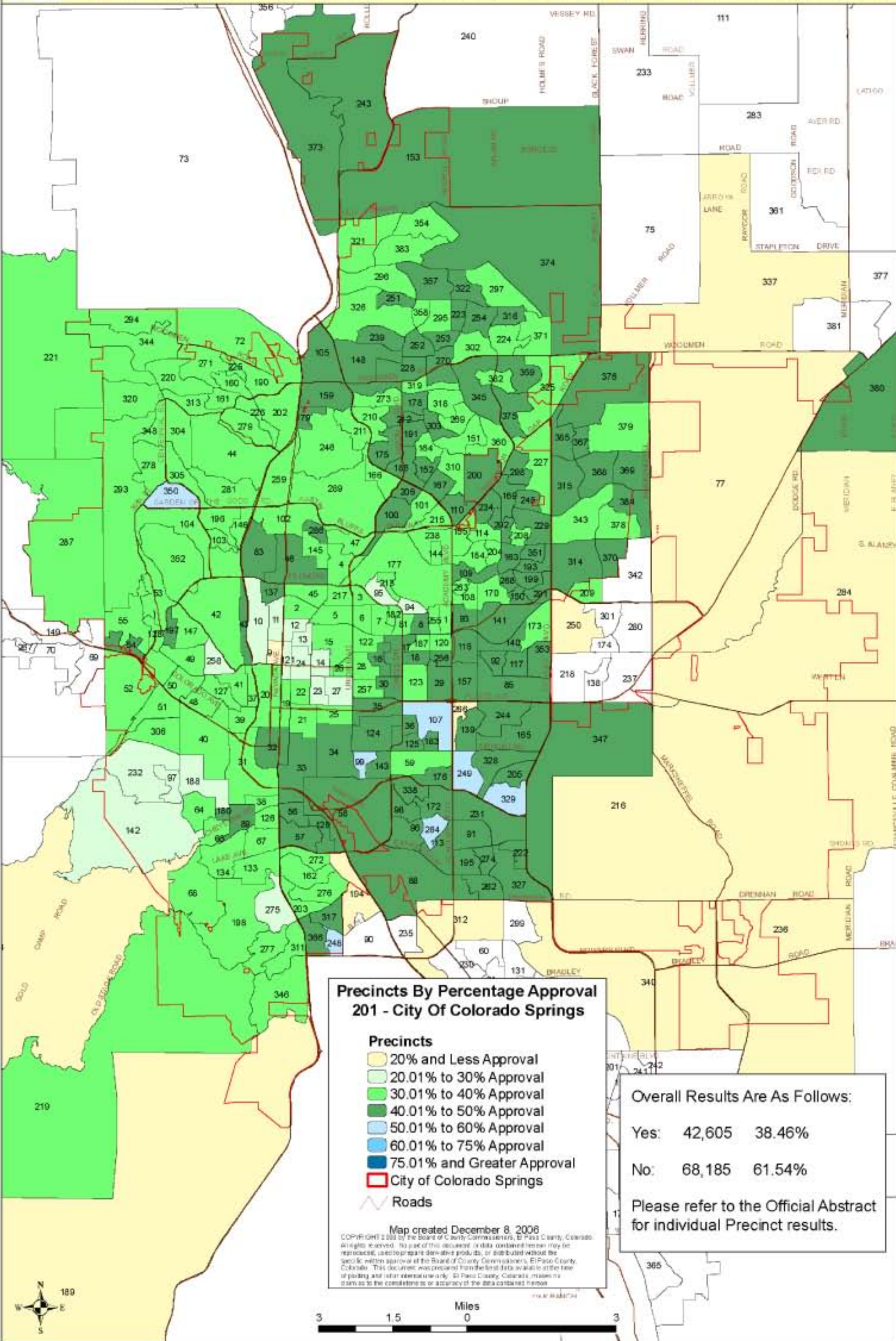
200 - City of Colorado Springs: Initiated Ordinance Regarding Revenue Changes

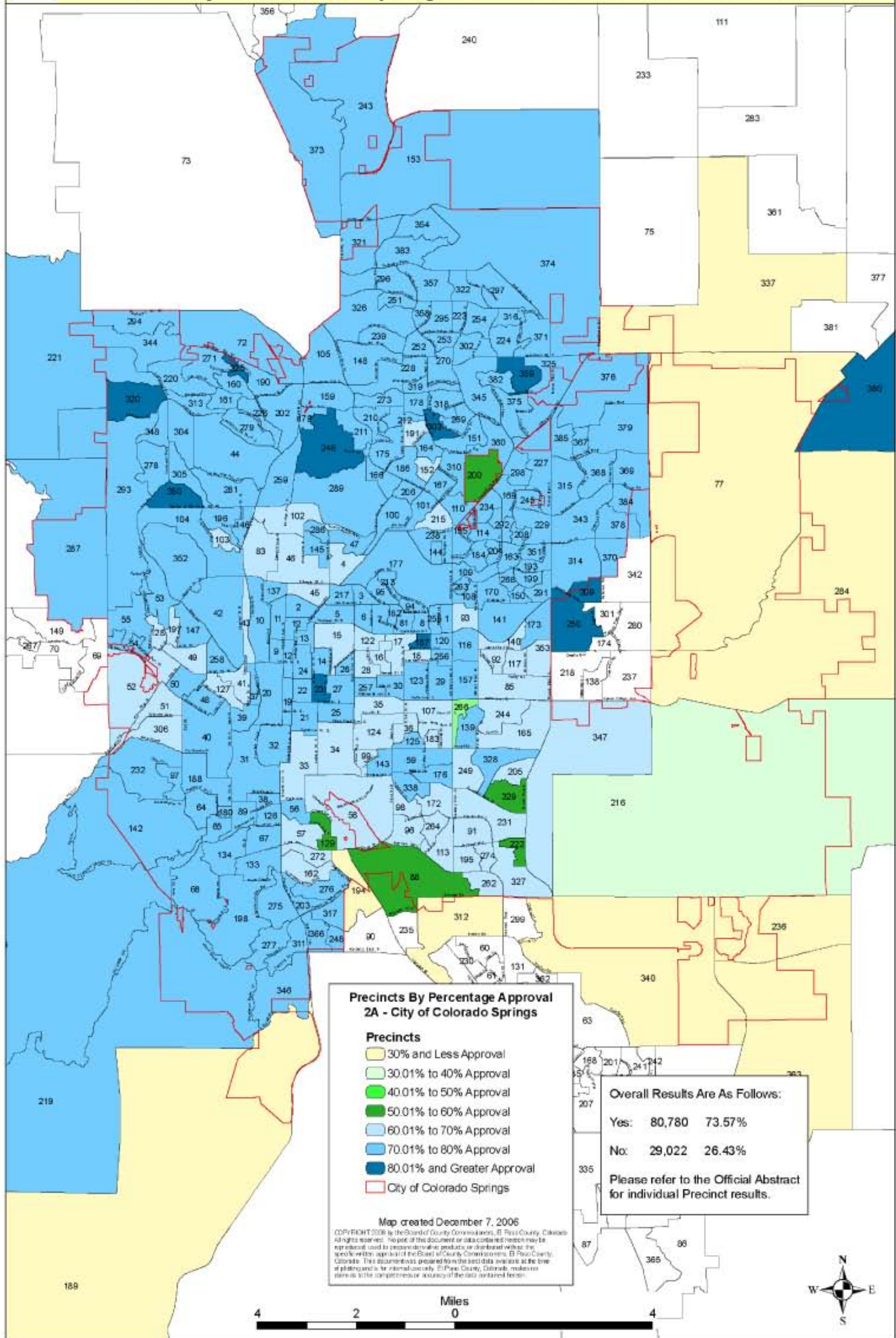
City of Colorado Springs: Initiated Ordinance Regarding Deficit Spending





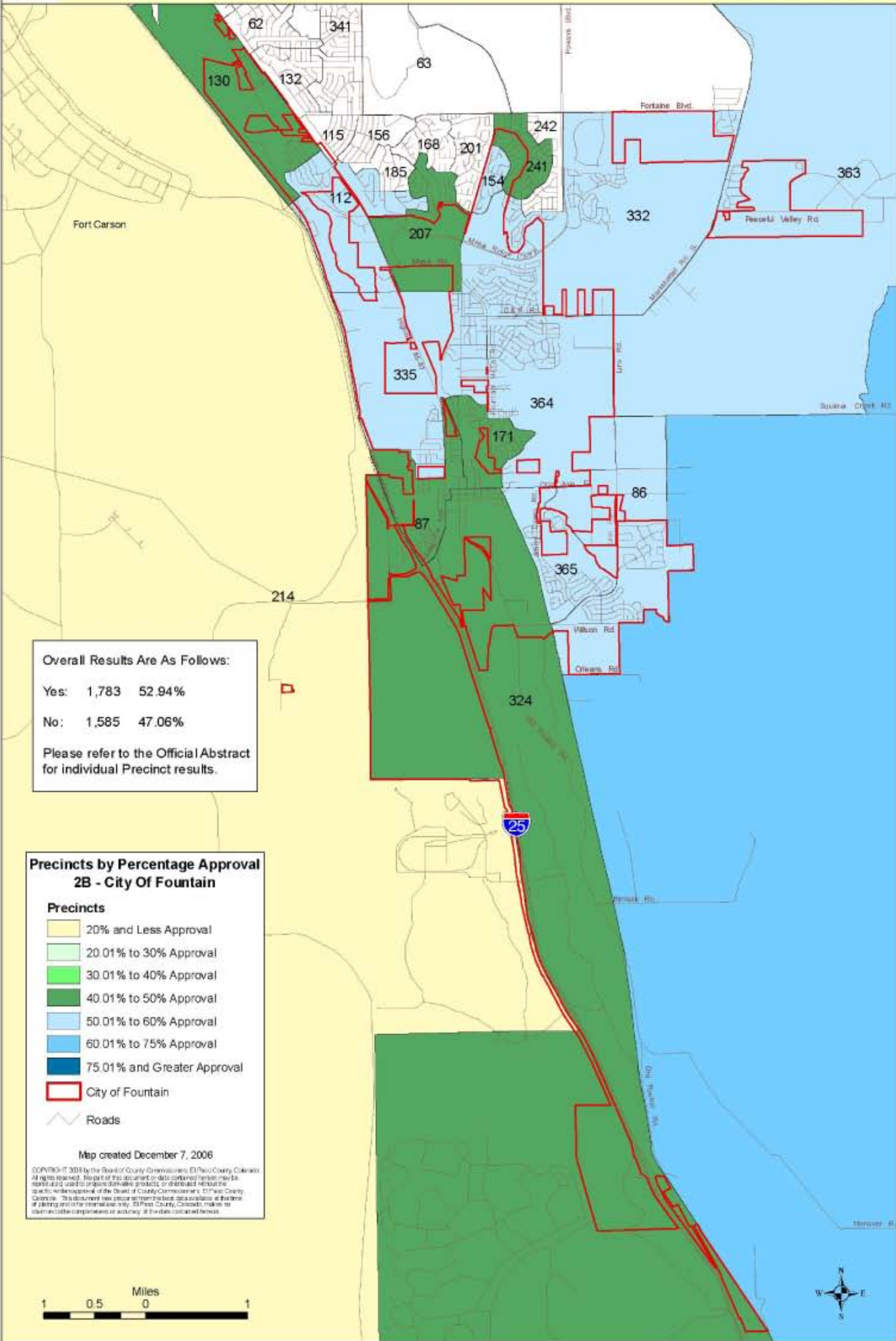

2A - City of Colorado Springs: Falcon Broadband Franchise



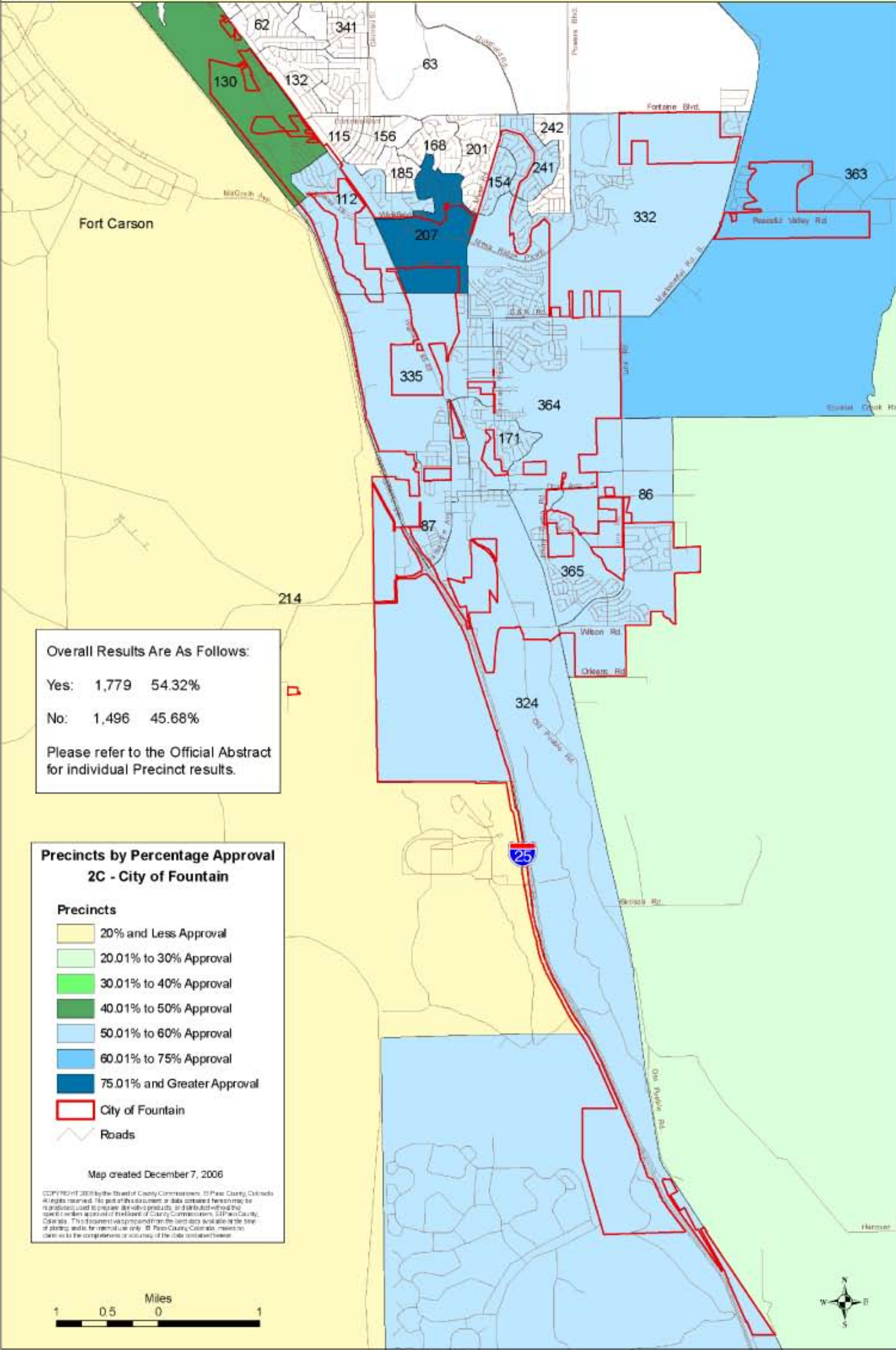

2B - City of Fountain: Charter Amendment



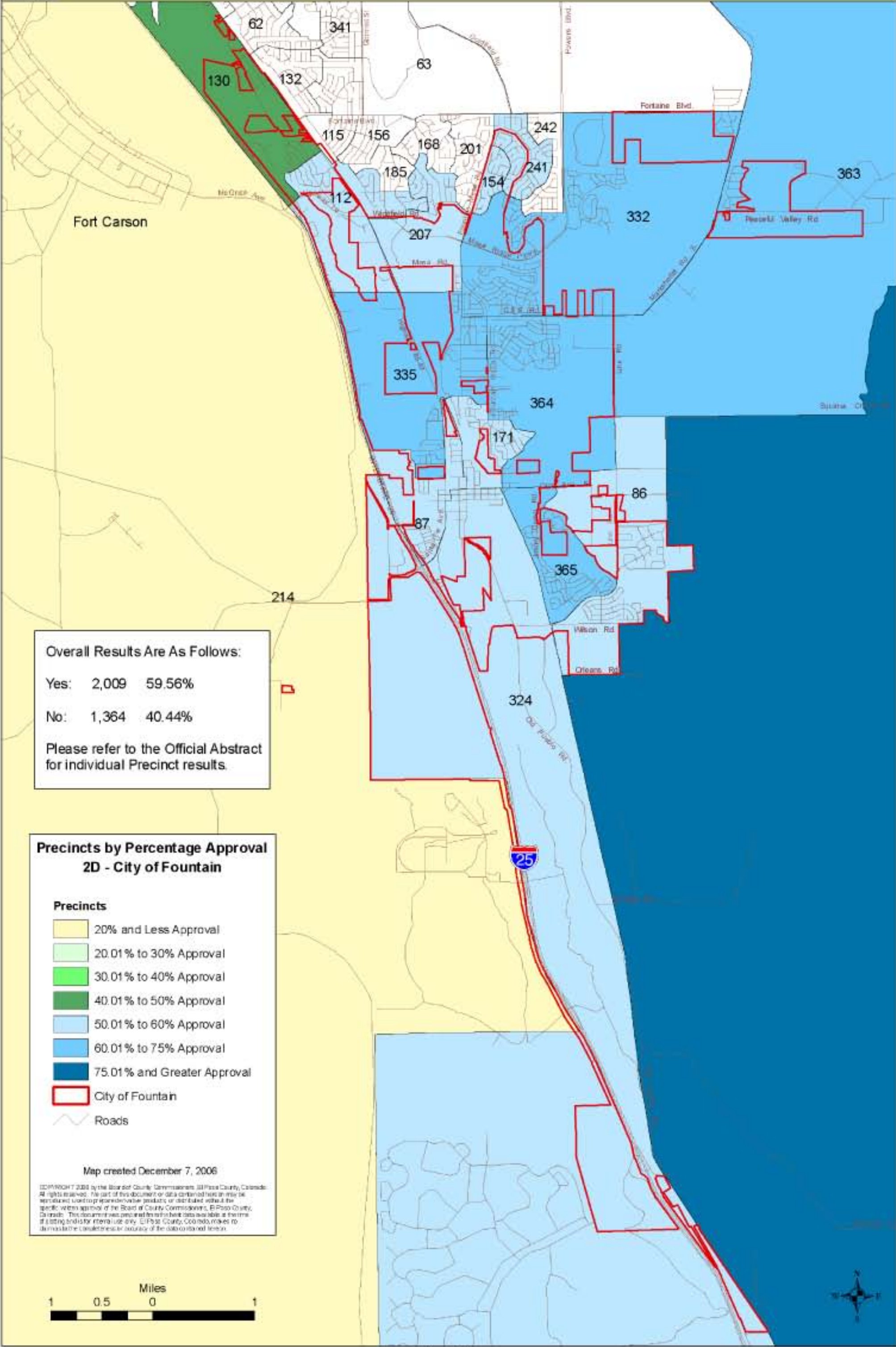

2E - City of Fountain: Charter Amendment



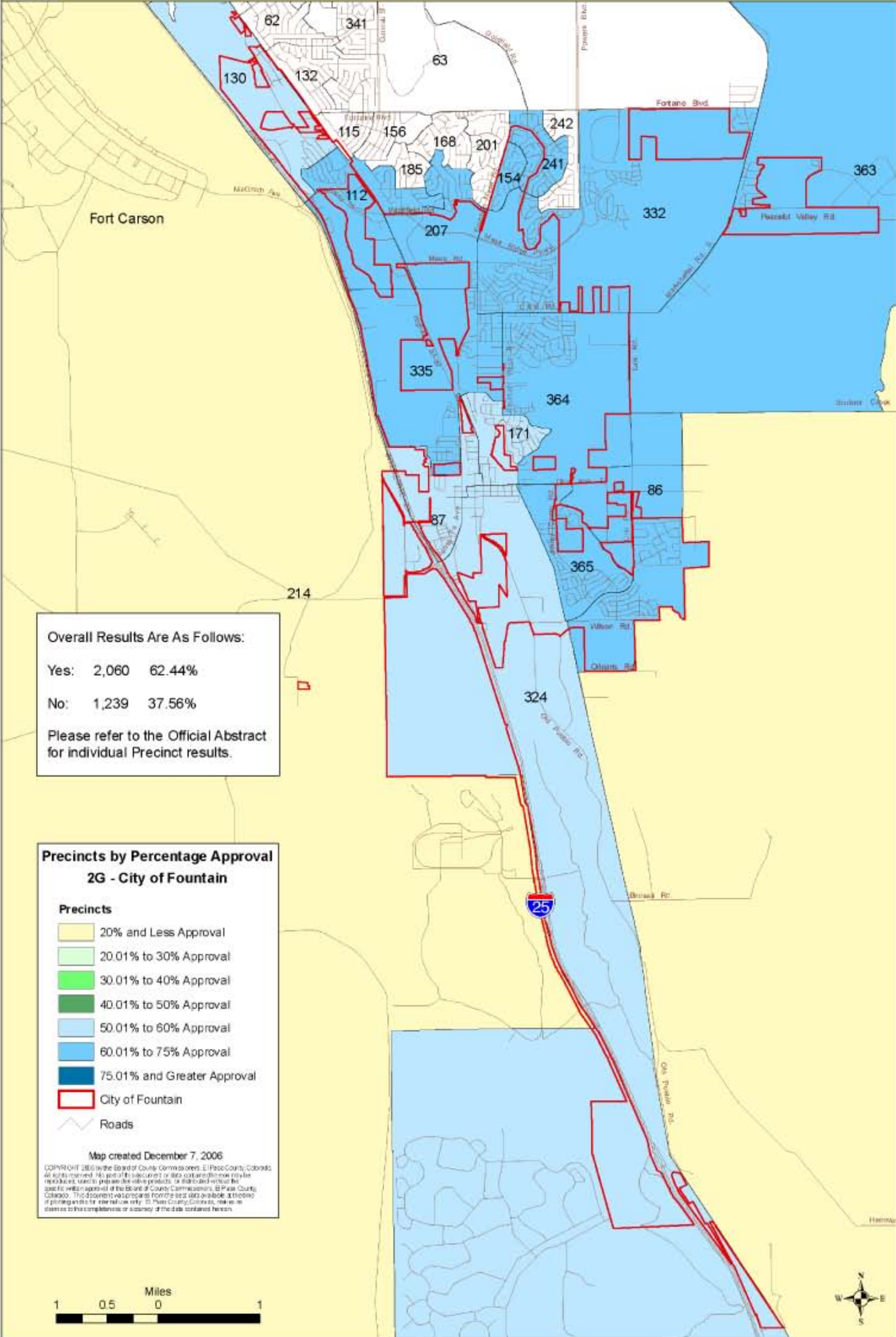

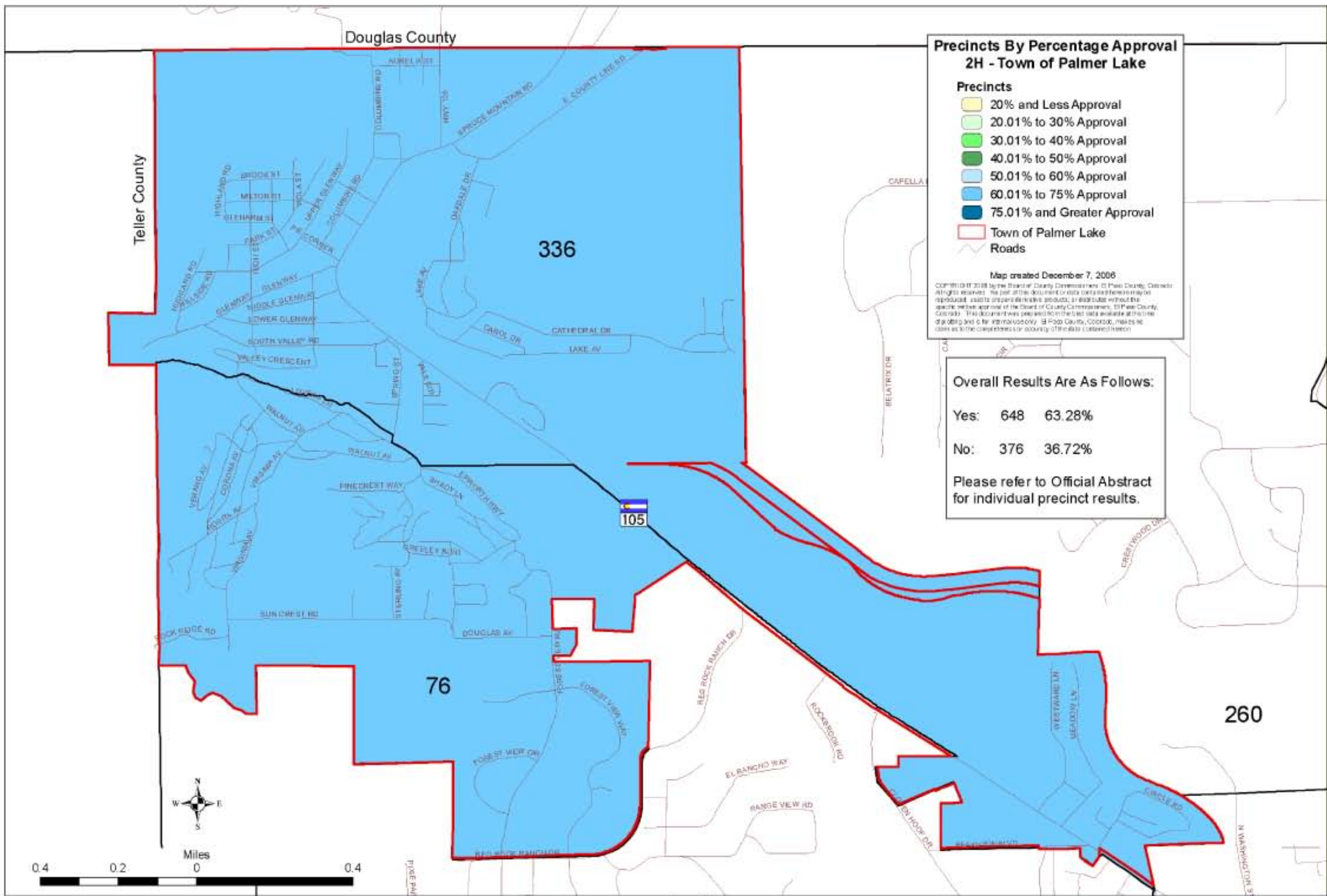
2F - City of Fountain: Charter Amendment

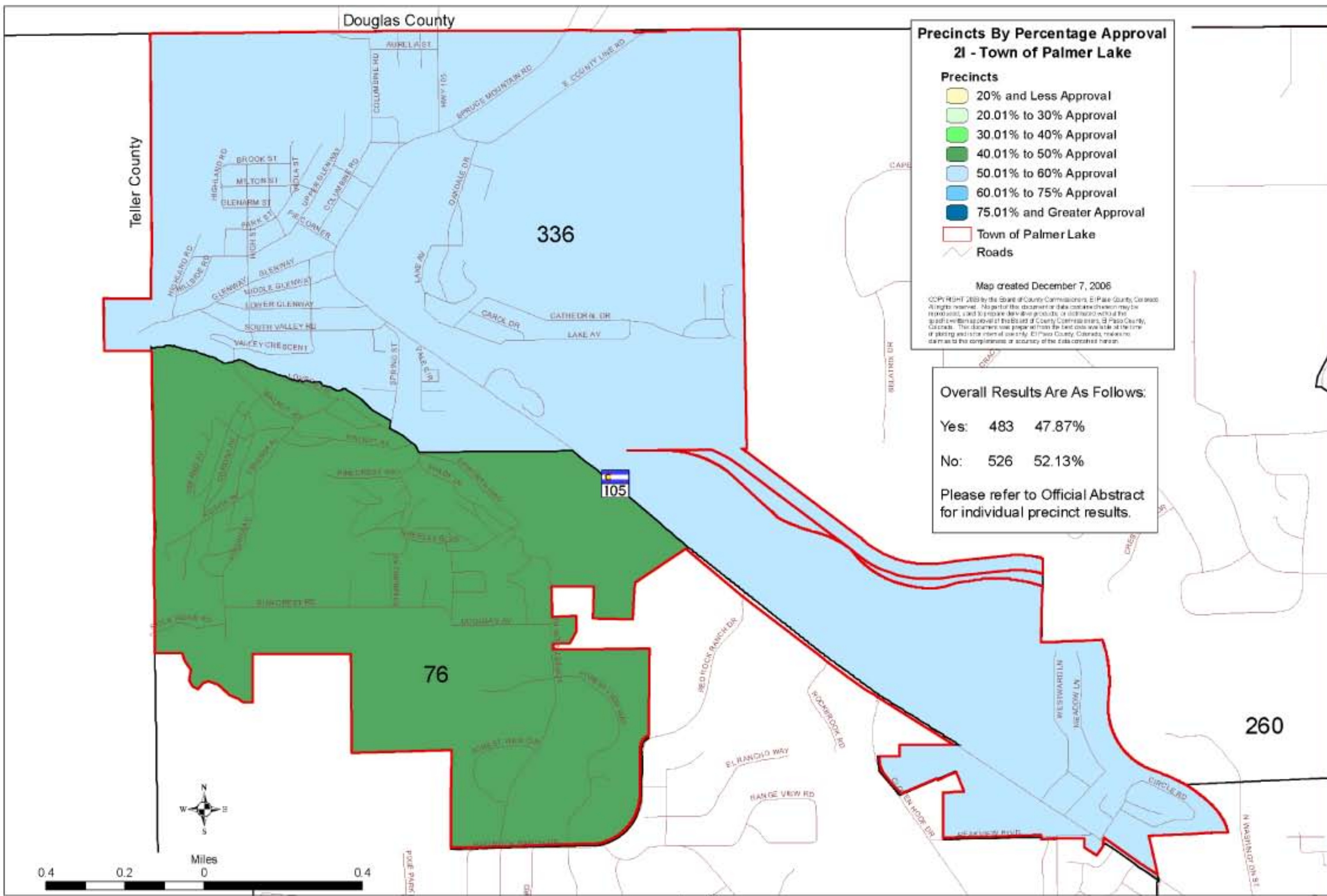

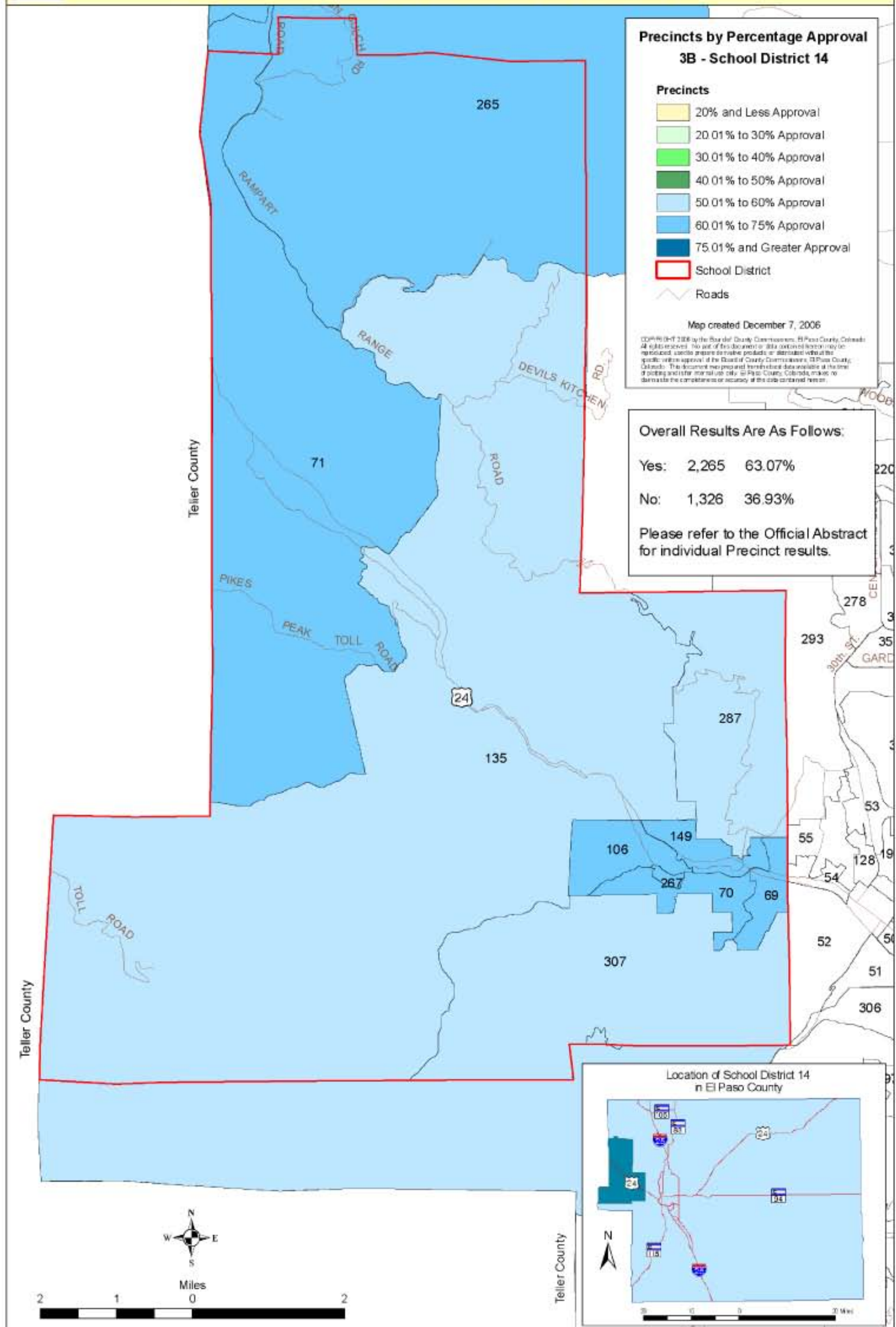

3B - Manitou Springs School District 14: Tax Increase



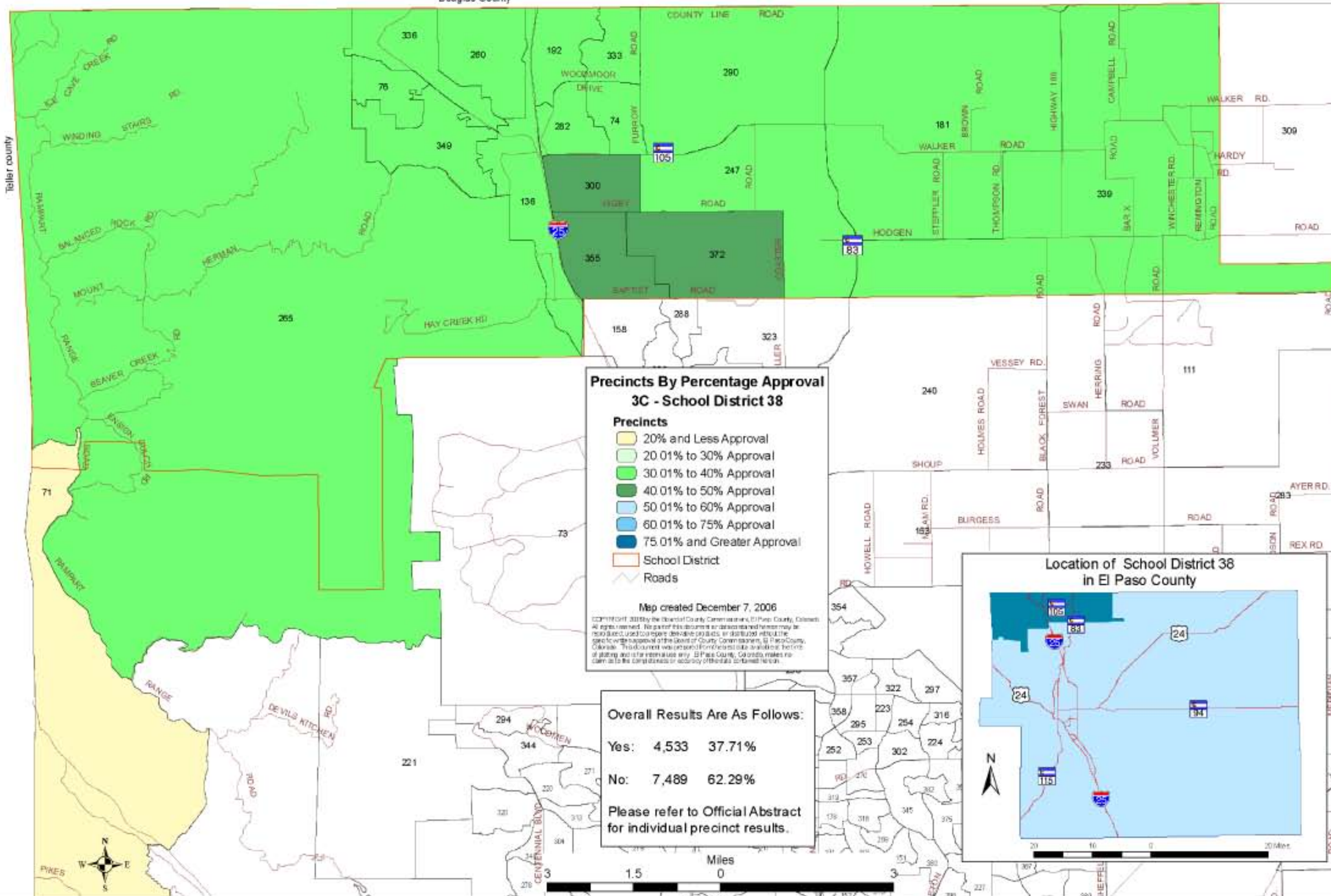


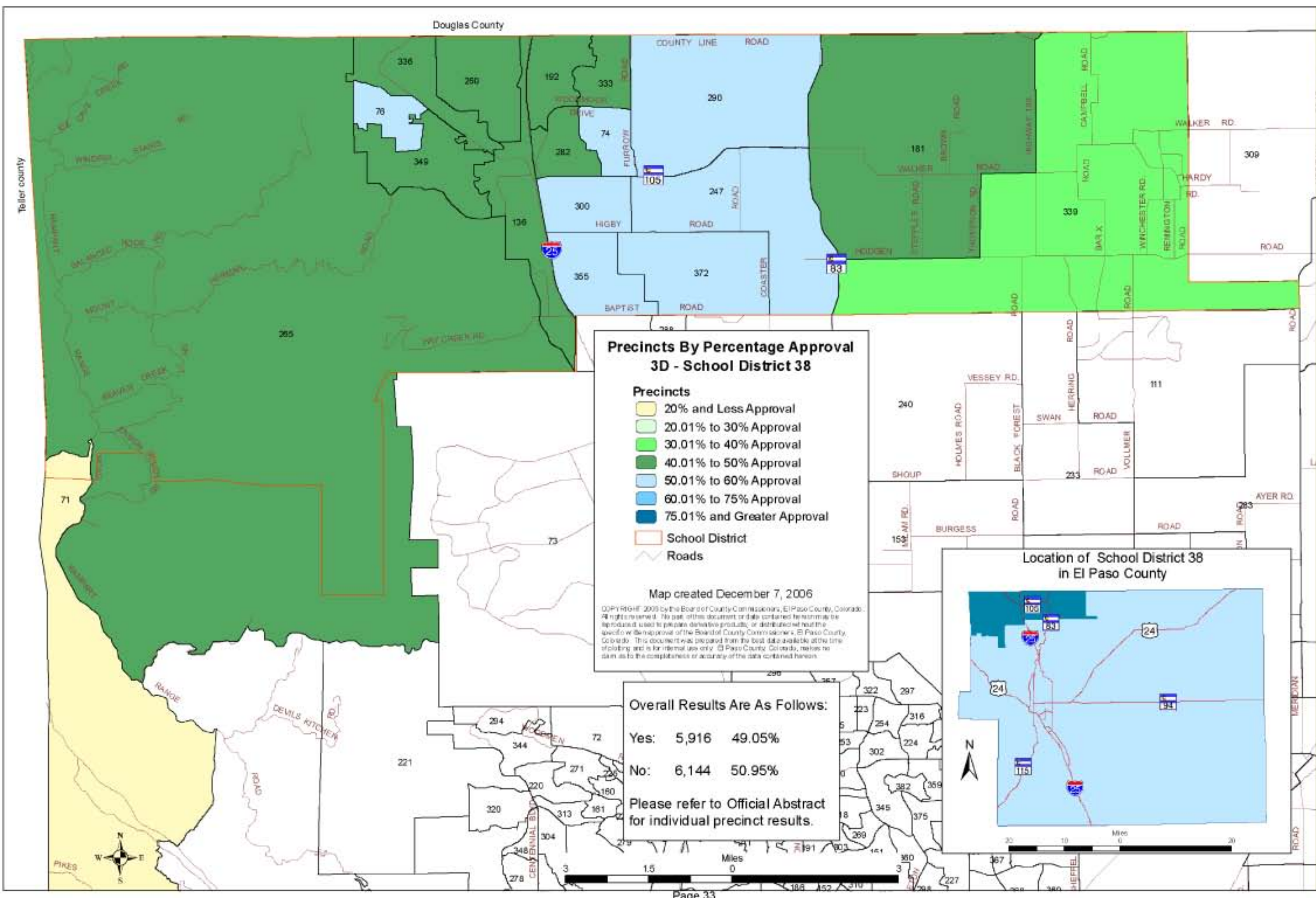

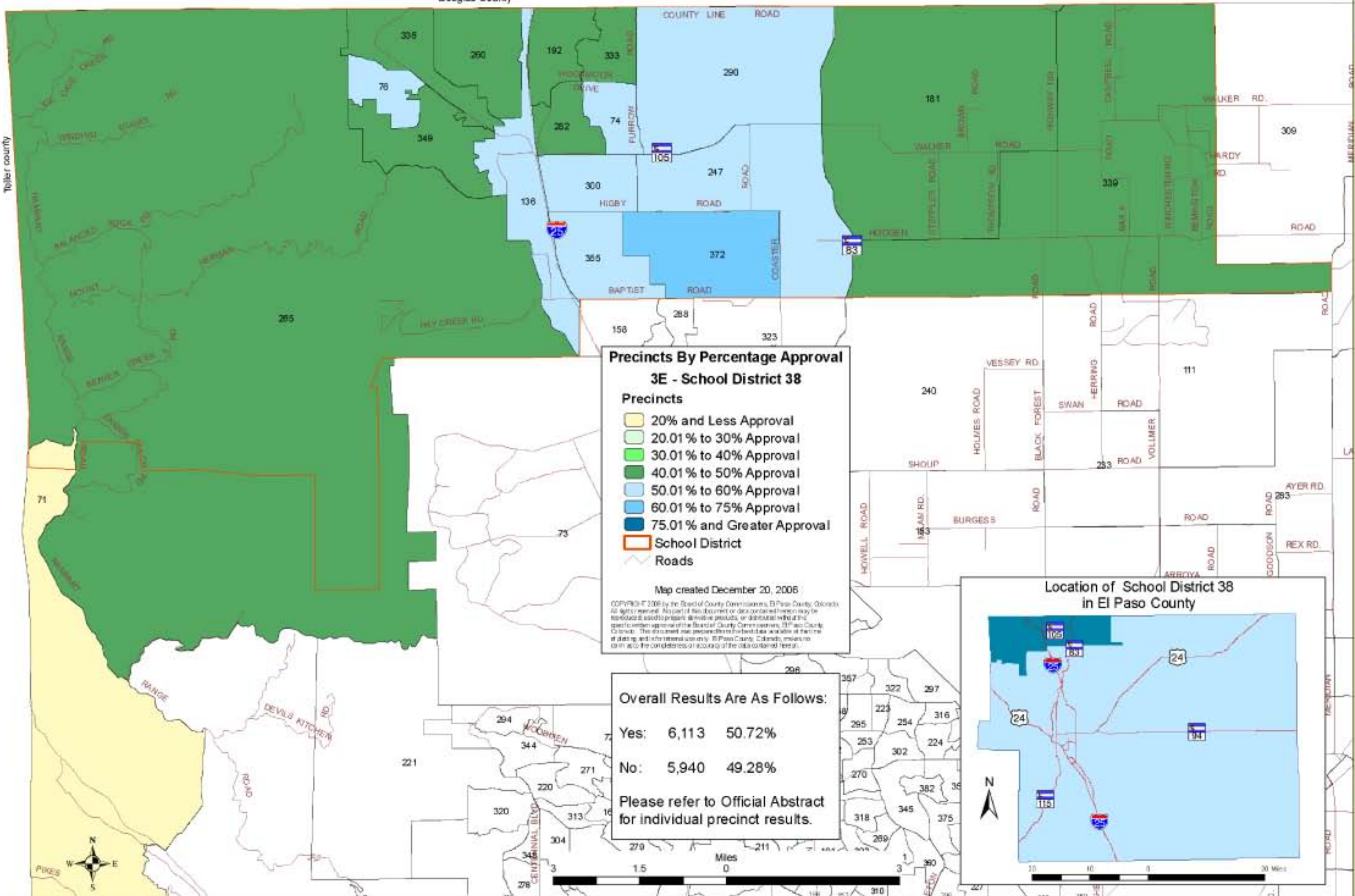

3E - Lewis-Palmer School District 38: Bond Question

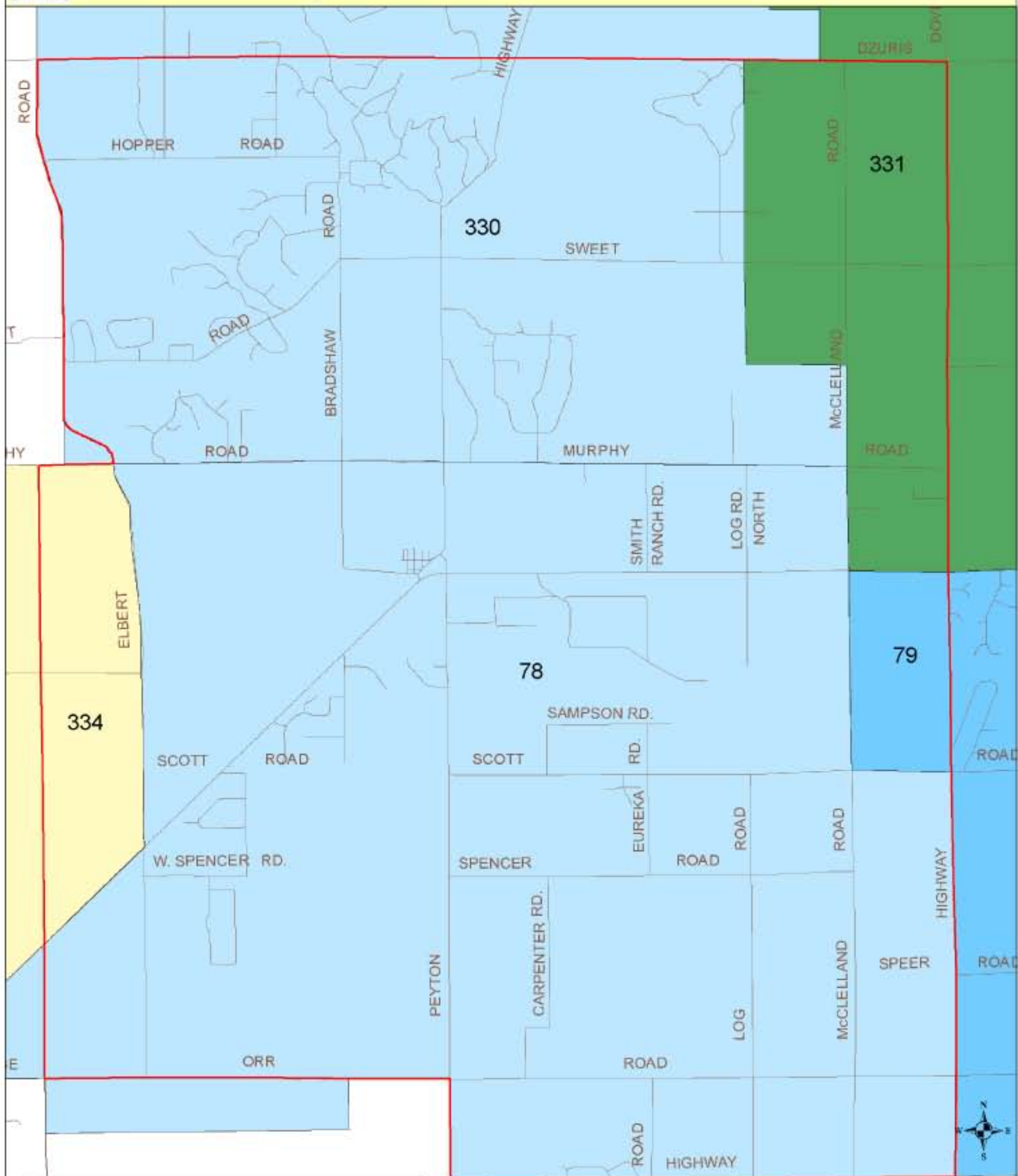

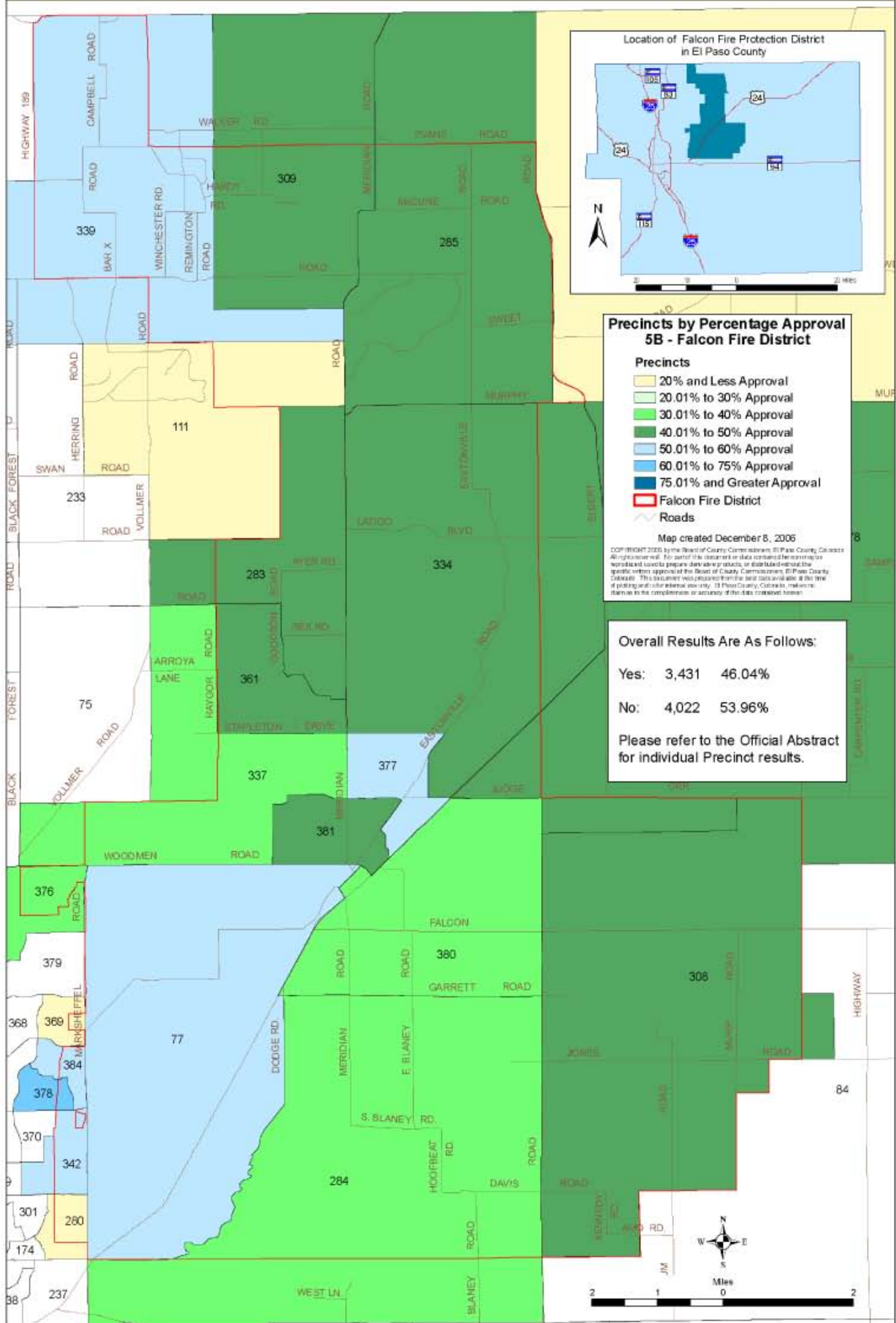

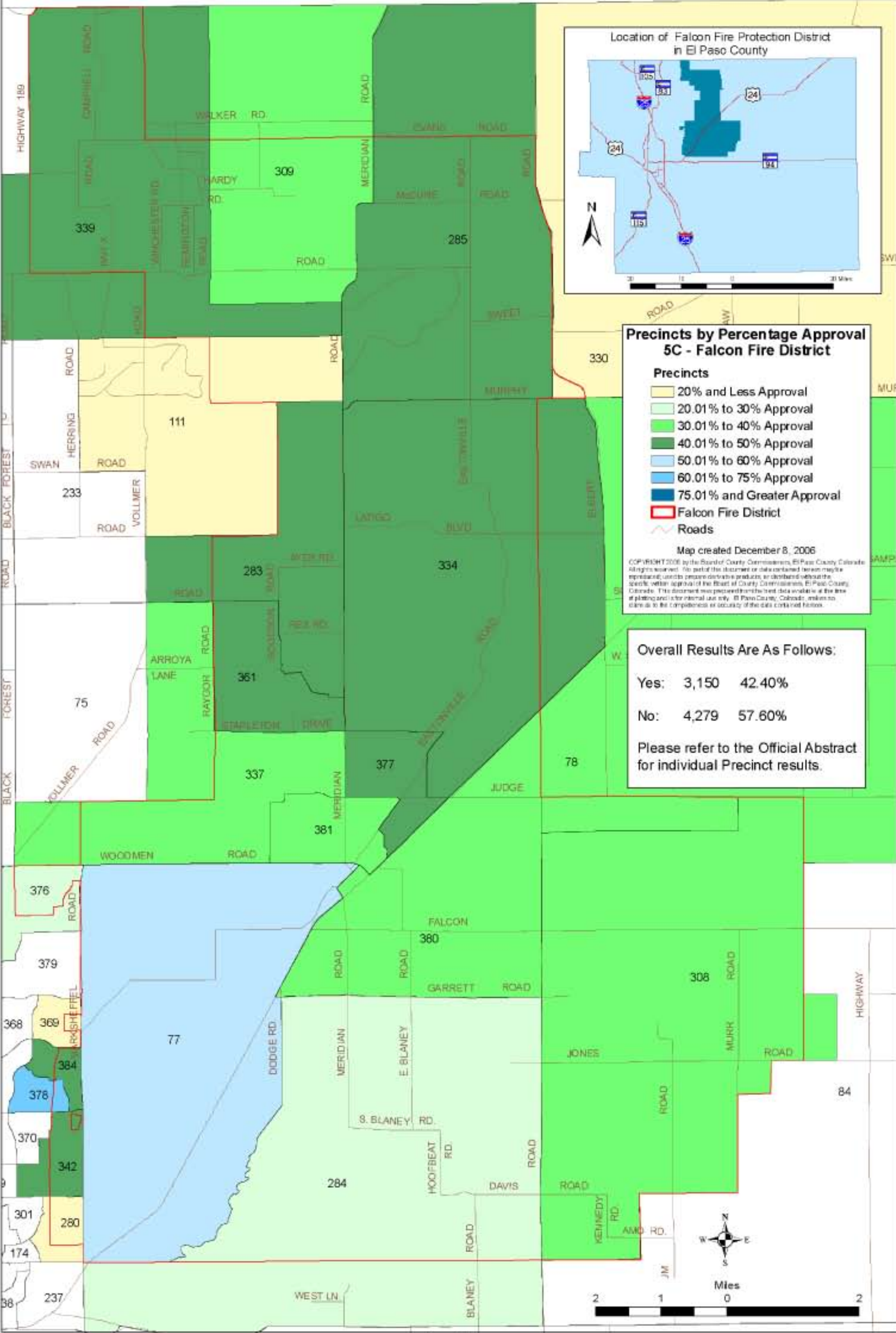
5B - Falcon Fire Protection District: Mill Levy Increase
